"We are excited to pursue this next step in our journey to see where the Lord may be leading us. We would value your partnership in prayer as we consider the many needs of the world and where God can use our gifts and strengths to best serve Him."

This was the closing paragraph to our first prayer letter and much has happened in the past month. The Lord has directed and built upon the key words we stated in our previous letter; Obedience, yes, Avant, full time missions.

Upon announcing our commitment to Avant and full time missions to family, friends and our church, the next steps we prayed through was completing a VISION TRIP to Mali, West Africa and also to Ankara, Turkey. In discussion with Avant leadership these were the two top places for us to consider based on need, fit, our family, and potential ministry.

We prayed about a possible trip in the fall and realized there was still a window of time left in the summer where the girls could be taken care of and youth ministry would not be hindered.

Within weeks we applied for visa's, obtained vaccinations, scheduled the kids guardians, hosted a garage sale, sold a vehicle and with miraculous gifts and confident answers to prayer we had the full funds and complete affirmation to head overseas for a two week vision trip!

So on August 23rd April and I said goodbye to the girls and boarded a plane for Mali, west Africa. It was an extra blessing to have a short layover in Paris and get to see Dave's sister and family (new niece of 7 weeks). After a week in **MALI** we then traveled on to Ankara, TURKEY and eventually arrived home September 5th, just in time for the first week of school to resume.

Obviously we have so much to say about a full two weeks on a vision trip of this magnitude. We asked lots of questions, met several key leaders and missionaries. Our senses were full with the taste,

feel and immersion of both countries. We earnestly prayed that the Lord would speak to us daily through the experiences we would have. Every encounter in each country was amazingly diverse. From the people, to the spiritual needs, to the infrastructure and stability of government, and even to the style of ministry that is best effective in each place.

It was so much to take in that we decided on our flight home to take a week to pray and process all the Lord was showing us. We did admit that Mali grabbed our HEARTS in many ways but we didn't want to jump to any conclusions based on feelings.

So after a week home of readjusting to our "normal" pace of life (which included sharing our experience with our girls) and much prayer as a family we have a true sense of **PEACE** about God's calling on our lives to advance the gospel of Jesus Christ in MALI!


