Dave and April both grew up as missionary kids. Dave to Indonesia and April to Haiti. They met in college (Moody Bible Inst.) in 1998 while individually pursuing careers in ministry. Their first ministry as a couple involved volunteering at a local church to help lead worship and minister to teens. This was part of God's leading in their relationship and so, upon completion of Moody, they were married in 2001.



Within months of being married they began their first of three vocations in youth ministry within the local church. During their 13 year period of ministry God blessed Dave and April with four precious daughters; Emma, Hailey, Kylie and Claire.







Help us Make it to MALI

In December 2012 Dave and April attended a missions conference called Urbana. This was where they first met Avant Ministries (formerly Gospel Missionary Union) and learned of their passion for planting churches in the least reached nations (less than 2% evangelized).

After Urbana things moved at a rapid pace for the Cousens family. 2013 involved applying to Avant, attending their pre-field training, and being appointed by Avant as full time missionaries. Due to their passion for planting churches among university students the Avant leadership recommended Mali as a potential field. In August 2013 Dave and April took a one week vision trip to Mali to discern their potential ministry fit.

Through various confirmations and much prayer the Cousens family are now being led to Mali. With a clear direction and purpose they began to jump into full time prayer and financial support raising, as well as begin the transition from their current church ministry in Wisconsin (which concludes in June 2014).

The next step in their family journey is to start French language school in **Albertville** France on September 1st 2014 (a 9 month intensive course). They hope to then move directly to Mali in summer 2015.
